This show will be electronically verified with the USEF. Provided you have submitted a COMPLETE entry form, including all required numbers and signatures, you will not be required to show us your membership cards, measurement cards, or recording cards. We <u>WILL NOT</u> look up your numbers for you. If you have applied recently, online, you will be given an instant number so include it on your entry. Please do not mail Memberships to USEF, they will not be electronically verifiable for weeks and we will be required to charge you non-member fees. Incomplete entry forms will be required to show proof of membership, etc. before your number will be required to be relaxed.

CLOSING DATES

Stall counts must be finalized three weeks before the show. Horse stalls may be paid online or a check may be mailed. Tack stalls do not need to be prepaid. After the closing date, stalls are not refundable and there is no guarantee we will be able to accommodate additional reservations.

2021 USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 ShowPass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Federation Entry Agreement: By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry form as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longuer and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc., (the "Federation") and the local rules of the World Equestrian Center. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under these rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

STATEMENT AS TO FEDERATION FEE

(GR407.1-3) For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation Fee will be collected (\$15 shall be an Equine Drugs & Medication Fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs).


The Horse Show Management reserves the right in itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, their decision to be final.

The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in jumper classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interest of the show and its exhibitors.

Every horse entered for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but Management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, its members, directors and employees, contractors, sponsoring entities and facility harmless for any loss or accident to horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

Office Hours: Office closes at 5pm daily OR 30 minutes after the last class finishes, whichever comes FIRST. Adds for the next day must be completed before the office closes.

24 hour Security: 352.355.5380

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirements to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF SafeSport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at usef.com

Mandatory Microchipping went into effect on December 1, 2018. You will not be allowed to COMPETE any horse that has not been microchipped. The microchip must be uploaded to your USEF account. All horses that require a USHJA Registration will also require a microchip.

Stabling: All stalls (12 'x 12' and 12' x 14') are permanent concrete stalls with doors, stable comfort mattress systems, and fans in a climate-controlled barn. Stalls may not be occupied by more than one horse at a time.

Stall Reservations: Stalls for horses will be \$250 and must be secured with payment in full. Stalls will not be confirmed without payment. Cancelled stalls after 21 days before the start of the competition will not be refunded for any reason. Stalls can be ordered through showmanagementsystem.com until sold out. You can prepay your stalls online at the time of reservation with a credit card or you can choose CHECK as your payment method and we will email you a statement to send with your check.

Feed and Bedding: Must be ordered by emailing ocalastalls@wec.net at least 24 hours prior to your arrival to guarantee it will be delivered prior to your arrival. Forms are available in the stabling office to order feed and bedding during the competition. DO NOT order feed/bedding on your entry form, the stabling office does not see entries.

Grounds Fee: \$50 per show. Park in designated area only. Any horse not entered to show will also be charged the appropriate non showing fees.

Entry Closing: The entry closing date for mailed entries is received 14 days before the first day of the show, or the Monday before the show for online entries submitted at showmanagementsystem.com. Entries must be received by this date to be considered on time. Entries completed ONLINE at showmanagementsystem.com will not be charged a late fee until after 12 noon the Monday before the show. Late fee is \$25 after the closing date and \$50 if received after 12 noon the day before the show starts. *FEI entry closing dates refer to FEI Definite Schedule.

Checking In and Checking Out: All horses must leave a check or credit card on file. All accounts must be settled EVERY WEEK, in full, upon the conclusion of the final class on Sunday. Those that do not check out or leave an open check with the office will be charged a \$50 late check out fee.

For your convenience there will be exhibitor's terminals available in the show office; we encourage you to look at your account early in the week and make any corrections while the office is quiet. You can check out with your credit card at the exhibitor's terminal or online by request to the show office. If you wish us to fill in your open check for you, we will be happy to. Please print your statement at the exhibitor's terminal and write on it "please close out my check" and drop the statement in our basket; this will expedite your departure. If you are checking out more than one horse be sure to include a statement for each horse and explicit instructions as to whose check we use for which horses.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING SPLITTING/COMBINING & ADD/SCRATCH POLICY IN ALL "A" RATED HUNTER SECTIONS: Should entries warrant, all "A" rated hunter sections will be split or combined following USEF rules and will be done so at the close of the horse show office on the evening preceding the first class in each section, therefore entries MUST be completed for "A" rated hunter divisions accordingly to be considered. Any post-adds received and accepted after this time will not be considered in respect to the splitting/combining numbers. There will be no exceptions to this policy. Same day scratches and/or "no-shows" at the gate in all "A" rated hunter sections will forfeit their entry fee unless a Certificate from the Official Show Veterinarian vet scratch for the show is received by the official show secretary prior to the First class of the section in question. Should same day scratches or no-shows result in insufficient entries to keep sections split, sections will be combined. Adding Classes: Can be done directly through showmanagementsystem.com until 5pm the day before the class is scheduled.

Scratching Classes: Can be done directly in your showmanagementsystem.com account any time until the start of the class except "A" rated hunters cannot scratch same day. Same day scratches and/or "no-shows" at the gate in all "A" rated hunter sections will forfeit their entry fee unless a Certificate from the Official Show Veterinarian vet scratch for the show is received by the official show secretary prior to the first class of the section in question. Informing the starter that you do not intend to participate WILL NOT give you credit for the class. A horse on the grounds scratching all classes will become a non-showing horse regardless of the reason and will incur all fees associated with a non-showing horse. After showing in the first class of any "A" rated section requiring a section entry fee, no refunds will be given for scratching any classes within the section for any reason.

Non-Showing Horses: All horses on the grounds are required to have a signed entry form in the office, whether they are showing or not. This entry form must include signatures and a complete description of the horse. Non-Showing horses will pay a fee of \$150 per show plus \$18 night watch. Scratched horses on the grounds are considered non-showing horses regardless of the reason.

Award Ceremonies: Riders are required to ride for awards in all Classics/Grand Prix, unless notice of ceremony cancellation has been given. Failure of a rider to be present may result in forfeiture of all prizes won in the class. Competition management reserves the right to require participation in any tie-breaking procedure in order to determine a winner of a competition or championship. Refusal to participate in the tie-break procedure (if required) may include, but is not limited to; forfeiture of prize money and/or elimination from the competition. The decision of management is final.

Payment Method: Show Fees/bedding/feed may be paid by cash, check drawn on an American bank, or any major credit card (@3% fee).

Returned Checks/Credit card chargebacks: Checks returned by the bank or chargebacks on credit cards transactions for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled as follows: A 10% Penalty will be assessed for every returned check or credit card chargeback (Minimum of \$50). Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be reported to USEF for collection/disciplinary action.

Prize Money/Awards: An IRS W9 needs to be completed showing the proper prize money recipient and their SS or FED ID#. Care must be taken to be sure the information matches that of the IRS. Prize money will be deducted from your account upon closeout in the office provided you have submitted the required W9 or W8 for Foreign exhibitors. Balances will be paid in the form of a check mailed to the named recipient on the W9 within 30 days after the conclusion of the show. The IRS W9 form is available in the show office/through Show Management System account. All Hunter purses shall be divided as follows unless otherwise specified: 1st-30% / 2nd-22% / 3rd-15% / 4th-12% / 5th-11% / 6th-10%.

Refunds: Entries canceled prior to the closing date will be refunded in full. Stalls and processing fee are not refundable for any reason after the closing date. All entry scratches must be submitted in writing to be considered for a refund. All accounts become final after the close of the show, changes will not be considered after this date, no exceptions! Please look over your statement carefully before checking out. If the show must be stopped due to a storm, accident, or other emergency, the show management has the right to deny a refund of any or all fees.

Processing/EMT/Night Watch: \$50 Processing Fee for each horse, per show, \$35 EMT Fee & Horse Ambulance fee, and \$18 Night Watch Fee. The Processing Fee is a non-refundable fee will also entitle each horse to **properly** add/scratch regular classes at no additional cost.

Arrival and Departure: Horses may arrive after 3pm on Monday and depart no later than 7am Monday. Early arrival and late departure must be arranged directly with the stabling manager.

Health Requirements: Florida regulations require that all equines be covered by official interstate health certificates, issued by a licensed veterinarian, showing that the animals are free from any symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease. The certificate shall include the name of the owner and address, destination in Florida, number of horses examined, the name, registration number(s), if any, tattoo, if any, sex, age, rectal temperature, color, and markings of each animal listed. Health certificates will become void after 30 days from issue. Health certificates must show animals to be negative to an equine infectious anemia test within the past 12 months. Date of test and approved laboratory must be shown on health certificate. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by

Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. 5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

Rings: WEC Grand Arena is 320' x 400; Stadium – 390' x 390; Jumper 1 – 200' x 300; Jumper 2 – 200' x 300; Indoor 1 – 171' x 530; Indoor 2 – 192' x 525; Indoor 3 – 192' x 525; Indoor 4 – 192' x 525; Hunter 1 – 175' x 300; Hunter 2 – 175' x 300; Hunter 3 – 175' x 300; Hunter 4 – 175' x 300; footing is GGT mix.

Courtesy Circle: In some instances it may become necessary to restrict the area of the courtesy circle by a mandatory line. If this is implemented, it will be clearly marked on the course chart and a corresponding barrier will be erected on the course. A public announcement will also be made.

Motorized Vehicles: May be used outside the buildings on designated paths. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Dogs - Leash Law: Dogs and other pets must be on a leash at all times while on the show grounds. Fines may be imposed for dogs not on a leash.

RDNE (Rode Did Not Enter): Entries that show in a class that was not properly entered either online, by inclusion on your original entry form, or a properly filled out add slip PRIOR to the class involved will be charged a \$25 RDNE Fee, and you will not be considered for an award in that class. This charge will show on your statement as "entered off judge's card". All adds must be done in the office by 5:00 P.M. the day before the class in question to assure acceptance.

Medical Waste: Sharps must be placed in proper receptacles located in each barn. Failure to do this will result in a \$100 fine or other penalties deemed necessary by the show management.

Protective Headgear: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent, guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

Poling: Manual poling and the use of bamboo offsets are prohibited at all times on the grounds of the World Equestrian Center. In the event of a violation of this rule, the involved horse and its trainer of record as indicated on the entry form will be suspended from further competition at the show in which the violation occurred. In addition, no refunds will be given for any unused fees.

Emergency Information: All horses must have an emergency information card attached to their stall for contact purposes. Please be sure to fill one out and attach it to your stall. Forms will be available in the show office.

Horse Show Championships: In all Hunter Championships, the titles shall be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points over fences. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in Under Saddle classes and half points for ribbons won in Model. Equitation Championships shall be equal points with ties broken by points over fences. Points awarded for all divisions as follows: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2 except Jumper bonus classes. Ties in USEF Hunter Championships shall be decided as specified in the USEF Rule Book. Others shall remain tied and shall flip/draw for the awards. Ties in Jumper divisions to be decided by the bonus class placing, if still tied they shall remain tied and entries shall flip/draw for the awards.

All subsequent published revisions, the provisions of which will take precedence. An arbitration procedure is provided for in the FEI Statutes and General Regulations referred to above. In accordance with this procedure, any appeal against a decision rendered by the FEI or its official bodies is to be settled exclusively by the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) in Lausanne, Switzerland.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE: The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise. VETERINARY EXAMINATIONS, INSPECTIONS & PASSPORT CONTROLS: These will be carried out in accordance with the Veterinary Regulations, Art. 1011 & the discipline rules, "General Regulations", 23rd Edition, Revision effective 20th April 2014, will apply: In accordance with Art.139.1. Every horse entered for any competition at CNs or CIMs (see Appendix D) in a foreign country (see GR 141.2), and all horses entered for other CIs, CIOs, Championships, Regional and Olympic Games, whether at home or in foreign countries must have a valid official FEI Passport, or a National Passport approved by the FEI and accompanied by an FEI Recognition Card and, when applicable, an FEI registration number, as a means of identification and to establish ownership. In accordance with Art. 139.2. Horses taking part in CNs and CIMs (see Appendix D) in their country of residence are not required to have a passport as is mentioned in paragraph 1. All such horses must be properly registered and identifiable and, unless there is no national requirement for equine influenza vaccination in the host country and in the country of origin, all horses must have a valid vaccination certificate.

EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION, (Vet Regs. ANNEX VII): All horses and ponies for which an FEI Passport or a National Passport approved by the FEI has been issued must have the vaccination section endorsed by a veterinarian stating that it has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza, given between one and three months apart. In addition, a booster injection must be recorded as having been given within each succeeding 6 months, subsequent to the second injection of the primary vaccination. None of these injections must have been given within the preceding seven days including the day of the competition or of entry into the competition stables. The above are the minimum requirements for influenza vaccination. Both primary and first and subsequent booster injections should be given according to the manufacturer's instructions which will fall within the stipulation of the FEI ruling.

SAMPLING FOR PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES, (VET. REGS, CHAP. V & VI AND ANNEX IV): Regular sampling is carried out in CCIs (3*, 4*), CSIs (3*, 4*, 5*), CIOs, World Cup Qualifiers and Finals, Championships and Games, whereas at other CIs sampling is recommended. The number of horses tested is at the discretion of the Testing Veterinarian/Veterinary Delegate, however a minimum of three is recommended (Art. VR 1016). Special guidelines are applicable for events covered by the FEI Medication Control Programme (Group I & II only).

INSURANCE: All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

Refer to the Official FEI Definite Schedule for all details and class specifications. Amateur Owner riders make sure to check current USEF rules regarding competing in International and National events.

FEI Online Entry: Entries are required to be filed through the FEI Online Entry System by the athlete's Federation no later than the definite entry deadline. In addition, athletes are required to fill out an entry form and submit it to the show secretary. Entries will be accepted by the Organizer through the FEI Entry System.

FEI Stabling: Stalls will be 12' x 14' permanent, comfort matted, in a climate-controlled barn. Tack stalls (if available) are \$400.

Substitutions: Substitutions will be accepted until one hour prior to the jog/FEI Inspection.

Acceptance of Entries: Once a horse is entered and accepted by the show it may not be withdrawn from competition without the permission of management. Exhibitors shall be held responsible for the stabling fee and service fee of all horse entered by them or their authorized agents(s) even though payment of these fees is not submitted with the entry form. In any case, horses that have not shown in classes in which they have been entered shall forfeit their fees except if a horse becomes ill or is injured prior to the start of the class or classes entered. The entry fee in this case will be dropped, upon receipt of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian and presented to the show secretary prior to the start of the class or classes entered. Only certificates signed by the Show Veterinarian will be accepted. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to ccancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change rings or rotate judges; use dotted line; and to change the specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Award Ceremonies & Prize Money: Riders are required to ride for awards. Failure of a rider to be present may result in forfeiture of all prizes won in the class. All prize money will be deducted from account and any remaining balance will be paid within 30 days of the completion of the competition.

Schooling: All schooling shall be held under the inspection of the Steward in the designated schooling area. Designated schooling areas and schooling/lunging hours will be posted in the FEI Stable Area.

All hunter classes that require a jog will be run with an open numerical score announced at the end of each round.

Hunter Courses: Courses will consist of at least eight fences with changes of direction. Fences will simulate obstacles found in the hunt field, such as brush, post and rails, walls, in and outs, gates, etc. No bank or water jumps. Course diagrams will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the class. In some cases, the area of the courtesy circle may be restricted by a dotted line. Under Saddle classes to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. No martingales permitted. In High Performance, A/O and Junior classes, entries may be asked to hand gallop collectively one way of the ring, at the Judge's discretion. No more than eight shall be asked to hand gallop at one time. Minimum entry requirements: Management reserves the right to combine Sections with less than six entries. No split Section will be held with less than four entries. Handy Hunter Courses and jumps to simulate those found in trappy hunt country, and may include natural obstacles, a trot fence and a fence to lead over.

Stabling/Check-in: All horses competing in classes with \$25,000 or more in prize money MUST be stabled on the grounds and will be required to do a 24 hour check-in.

Attire: Formal attire required for all classes offering \$20,000 or more and ALL Classics. Proper attire in all other classes except Table II classes may be standard attire.

Order of Go: In classes offering \$5,000 or more and where management deems necessary all horses names and positions will be drawn by the computer and in cases with riders on multiple mounts the computer will adjust the order, if necessary, to a minimum of 8 horses between rides.

Ties: All ties for 1st place will be jumped off as specified; ties for other than 1st place will be decided by the time taken in the first round.

Declarations: All horses must be declared (entered) in classes in which they intend to show by 5:00 P.M. the day previous to the class to ensure entry to the class.

Cross Entry: Competition Management may restrict cross entries between High and Low sections at the same competition if stated in the prize list.

Rider: Riders competing in a Children's Jumper Classic may not compete in any other Jumper Classic, Welcome Stake, Mini Prix, or Grand Prix at 1.30m or above or in the highest prize money class of any 1.30m or above section at the same show.

Horse/Pony:n/a

Horse and Rider Combination: Low Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. Low Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered.

High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Junior Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m and above that offers prize money, at the same competition. High Children's Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered

Fence Height:

- Low Children's Jumper 1.00m to 1.05m
- High Children's Jumper 1.10m to 1.15m

Combining/Dividing Sections: Adult Jumper sections may be divided by or combined with Children's Jumper sections, at management's discretion, if so stated in the prize list.

Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section:

- Low Children's Jumper section
- High Children's Jumper section

- Course design must comply with EQ108.11 except combination is optional.
- Equitation 15-17
 - Minimum 3'0", maximum 3'6" management must state height at which class will be offered.
 - Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout.
 - Course design must comply with EQ108.11 except combination is required.
- Spreads not to exceed fence height

Combining/Dividing Sections: Age-Group Equitation Sections may be combined as necessary, jumping at their respective heights, to meet the three (3) entry minimum requirement for points to be awarded.

Stallions are prohibited when adult equitation sections are combined with children's/junior equitation sections. EQ101.3.

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree to be bound and abide by the rules, regulations, and policies of USEF as published in the USEF Rule Book and on the website at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including melmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").
