

## WORLD EQUESTRIAN CENTER VISITING FARRIERS

Hello Farriers,

World Equestrian Center (WEC) and FarriersInc, Official Farrier group, would like to extend a warm welcome for the 2024 show season! Having hosted nearly 100 farriers last year, we look forward to welcoming everyone back for another exciting year in 2024.

This document provides questions regarding shoeing at World Equestrian Center and initial guidance, instructions and protocols to be aware of.

- 1. When arriving at WEC, prior to working on horses, please visit the Official Farrier Station located in the NW corner of Barn E (stalls E70-E73) facing the Chapel. Sign the "Visiting Farrier" agreement to receive a 2024 Farrier/Work Pass. This is free and will only have to be completed once a year. 2023 Farrier/Work Pass holders will need an updated pass for 2024.
- 2. WEC welcomes all visiting farriers to work and manage their current clients/horses. Farriers may not solicit work at WEC, on or off the grounds. This includes written flyers, or social media posts.
- 3. There are two designated farrier buildings as well as small, covered buildings located next to the barns. Please bring extension cords if working in small, covered buildings.
- 4. Farriers may shoe in the barns, however there are protocols that must be followed. Most notably, no trucks or trailers are allowed inside any barn or arena, no shoeing in wash racks and no blocking overhead doors of any aisle way. Farriers may angle their vehicle at an overhead entrance door but a clear path for horses to get in/out must be maintained at all times.
- 5. A full explanation of WEC farrier protocols and parking will be provided at the time passes are received at the Farrier Station (Barn E, Stalls 70-73 Tuesday-Sunday during WEC managed competitions).
